If the certificate program requires the 60 semester-hours as a prerequisite (so the students only need to complete their 18 semester hours of substantive paralegal courses), that comes to the equivalent of 225 classroom hours. If the certificate program includes the 60 semester hours as part of the program, that comes to 750 hours, or a total of 975 classroom hours including the above 225 paralegal course classroom hours.
