

Stakeholder outreach will be achieved through a combination of meetings with stakeholder groups and surveys distributed to groups and individuals with whom it is not possible to meet. Input received from stakeholder groups will be provided to the Admissions and Regulatory workgroups for consideration in their respective drafts.

- The first target will be groups within the legal community. Meetings with these groups began in April and will continue throughout the summer.
- The second target will be community groups, especially those that represent likely client groups such as tenants and landlords.
- The stakeholder group will also conduct a survey that will be distributed to additional groups. The survey will specifically address questions of what unmet needs stakeholders see in their communities that licensed paraprofessionals may be able to assist with.
